Be it resolved by the Franciscan University Student Government (SG) that:

\$500 be reallocated from YAF's local business initiative kickoff to printing costs for the local business initiative.

The following is a breakdown of costs:

Recognizing that:

- YAF was awarded \$500 in the budget for a kickoff night for the local business initiative, but cannot put the event on due to limited time and resources. Instead, they wish to put the money towards printing costs for a directory of local businesses that will be distributed to all campus mailboxes during spring break. This will avoid draining the general Student Government printing budget. The cost to print the guides is estimated at \$0.48/copy.
- The initiative is called the Steubenville Stimulus Project and seeks to encourage students to shop at local businesses, using free market principles to inject hundreds of thousands of dollars into the local economy and help revitalize the area.
- No new money will leave the contingency fund as part of this bill. This is a reallocation of funds already allocated in the budget.
