Be it resolved by the Franciscan University Student Government (SG) that:
\$499.90 be allocated to buy printers for St. Francis, St. Thomas More, Trinity, Marian, St. Kolbe/ St. Clare, St. Louis/ St. Elizabeth and St. Bonaventure Halls.

The following is a breakdown of costs:

Epson- Workforce WF-2630 Wireless All-In-One Printer	\$49.99
